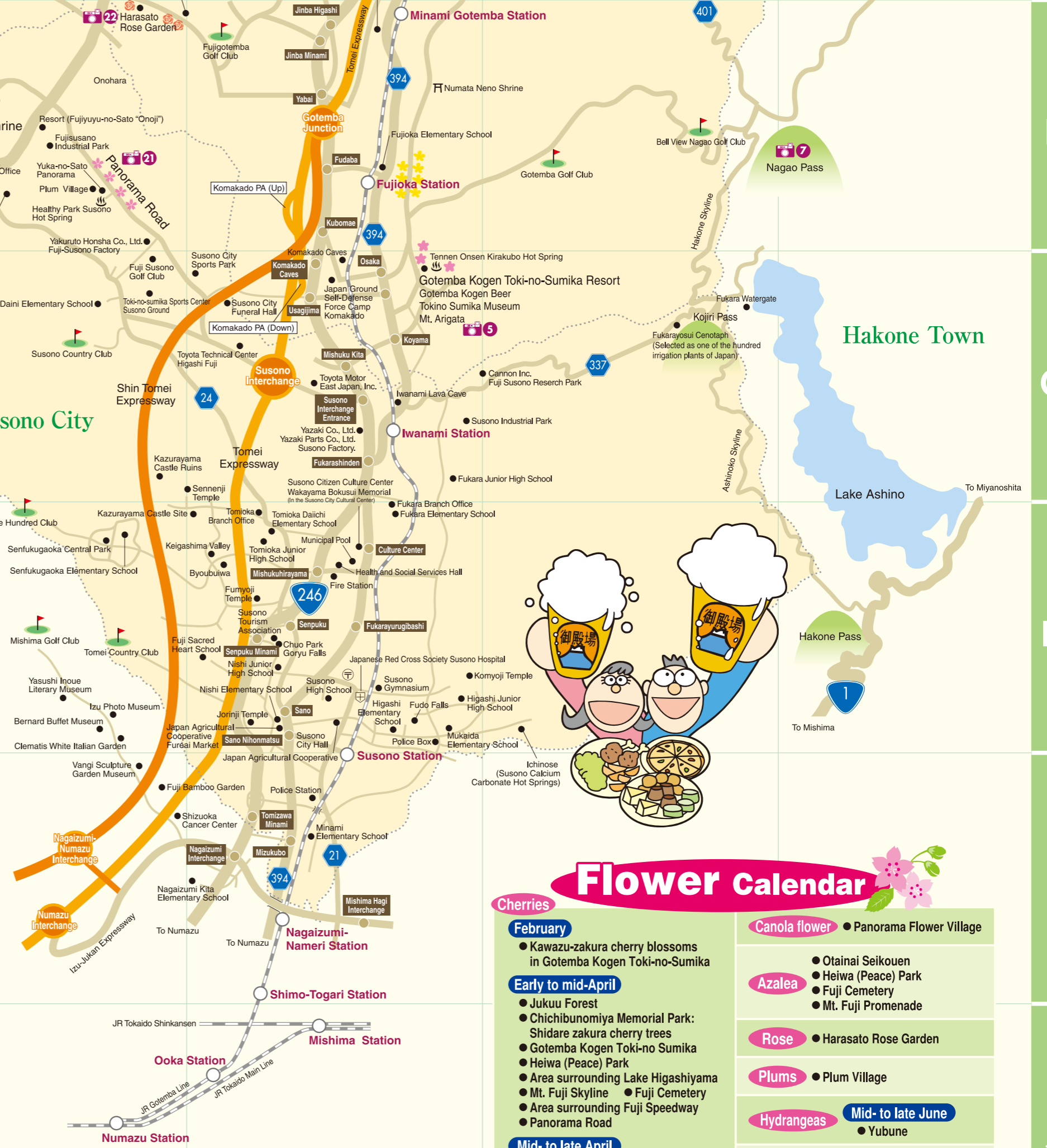


23 Best Recommended Photo Spots

If you want to take photos of great memory with Mt. Fuji, these places are recommended!

- 1 Mt. Fuji Subashiri Trail**
Oyama Town
Of all trails leading to the top of Mt. Fuji this is the easiest to climb. With abundant nature, you can photograph flowers, greenery, animals and birds.
- 2 Mt. Fuji Gotemba Trail**
Gotemba City
This trail is recognized as a Mt. Fuji view Heritage in Gotemba city. You can see and feel close to the majestic mountain.
- 3 Mt. Fuji Suyama Trail**
Susono City
The traditional Suyama Trail starts from Mizukatsuka Park, goes through the second crater of Mt. Hoel and joins the Fujinomiya Trail. The scenery from Gotemba is recommended.
- 4 Otome Parking**
Gotemba City
There is a bell called "Happy Call Bell" which many people ring to make a wish for happiness. Enjoy seasonal Mt. Fuji views surrounded by this bells sound.
- 5 Mt. Arigata (Gotemba Kogen Toki-no-Sumika)**
Gotemba City
You can see a symmetric Mt. Fuji with extensive gardens, green mountains and seasonally varying forests spreading in front. From the corner of the facilities area where Gotemba Kogen Hotel and a restaurant well-known for craft beer are located, glorious Mt. Fuji in its symmetric splendor can be seen, especially in the cherry blossom season.
- 6 Heiwa (Peace) Park**
Gotemba City
The great white dazoba is situated to face Mt. Fuji and its surrounding mountains. This natural park can be enjoyed throughout the four seasons. With only a 5 minute car ride from the Gotemba Interchange to the express way, the hill commands a panoramic view of Mt. Fuji and Gotemba City. The park is beautiful in all seasons with cherry blossoms in spring and colored leaves in autumn.
- 7 Nagao Pass**
Gotemba City
You can enjoy graceful "Feminine Mt. Fuji" and a breath taking view on this pass while enjoying a refreshing hike. Located on the prefectural border of Shizuoka and Kanagawa, the pass commands a grand view of Gotemba City and mountain ranges Mt. Fuji and Mt. Ashtaka standing in the distance, the scene reaches as far as Suruga Bay.
- 8 Dream Bridge (inside Gotemba Premium Outlets)**
Gotemba City
Mt. Fuji can be seen above the other end of this bridge. After shopping, you can take a photo with Mt. Fuji as a backdrop shining in a sunset glow.
- 9 Gotemba City Hot Spring**
Gotemba City
You can enjoy the Mountain View through steam rising from the hot spring. It's prohibited to bring a camera into the bathtub but please remember the view with your heart.
- 10 Otome Pass**
Gotemba City
A dignified appearance of Mt. Fuji can be seen from this pass named after the otome (maiden) myth. This is an ideal place for hiking and photography. After starting the hiking course from the Fujimi Teahouse in front of the Otome Tunnel on Route 138, it takes 40 minutes to get to this pass. This pass is known for the tragic story of a naive maiden.
- 11 Chikai no Oka**
Oyama Town
The Ashigara road is colored with history. At the top of the hill on the way up the Ashigara pass you will be fascinated as Mt. Fuji unexpectedly emerges just in front of you. In April and August you can see Diamond Fuji, an iconic image of Mt. Fuji silhouetted by the sun setting at the summit.
- 12 Mt. Kintoki**
Oyama Town
This is the highest peak of Hakone. The view of Mt. Fuji from this summit is breath taking when compared to others.
- 13 Fuji Cemetery**
Oyama Town
This cemetery is famous for greenery and cherry blossoms. From Fuji cemetery lookout, you have a full view of the cemetery and a calming beautiful Mt. Fuji.
- 14 Mt. Furou Western Peak**
Oyama Town
After passing through a thick mountain road, when you reach the western peak turning point, the view brightly opens up and Mt. Fuji emerges right in front of you.
- 15 Ashigara Takenoshita Terrace Paddy Fields**
Oyama Town
During the spring rice planting the paddy fields appears like a mirror surface reflecting a beautiful inverted image of Mt. Fuji.
- 16 Mizukatsuka Park**
Susono City
This park stands 1,500m above sea level. Mt. Fuji's powerful image emerges in front of your eyes. The park is a popular spot for colored leaves in autumn and in winter children can play in the snow for free.
- 17 Mt. Echizen**
Susono City
Mt. Echizen stands 1,504m above sea level and is the highest peak among the Ashtika Mountains. This mountain commands a panoramic view of Mt. Fuji, Suruga Bay and Izu Peninsula.
- 18 Jurigi Kogen Observation Deck**
Susono City
The observation deck is a 20 min walk on a promenade from Jurigi Kogen. It stands 980 m above sea level.
- 19 Mt. Fuji Promenade**
Susono City
This promenade in the middle of the Mt. Fuji Suyama Trail, is easy to walk with relatively few ups and downs. Rhododendron komiyamae, the flower of Susono City, turns vermilion in spring, while colored leaves from beeches and maples are seen in autumn.
- 20 Mt. Kurodake Observatory**
Susono City
The summit is divided into three peaks. This mountain commands a superb view of Mt. Fuji and the Suruga Bay area. (Elevation: 1,090m)
- 21 Panorama Road**
Susono City
When you drive a car towards grand Mt. Fuji that emerges in front on this road, you just feel great.
- 22 Harasato Rose Garden**
Gotemba City
You can enjoy Mt. Fuji and roses together. This is the only spot where you can see Mt. Fuji behind roses.
- 23 Kofuji Peak**
Oyama Town
With a 20-minute walk on the promenade from the Subashiri Trail 5th Station, you can experience the best view and emotions in Japan.
